Dear Mr. Fauser,

I have just finished our yearly "in house" ammonia audit. We were praised for our "mechanical Integrity" program and the main reason was because of our service contract with Cimco. These system checks are invaluable to keep on top of potential problems. They are also very good for checking parts of the system that are not in the routine path of our operators. We have found potential leaks, valve packing leaking and operational deficiencies. The fact that we get all the operational pressures by manually looking, gives us a benchmark to compare to our 100 or so sensors that we have located around the plant. We have been working closely with Cimco since 2006 and have found this program to be invaluable. Cimco have been with us for many years and besides being knowledgeable of our ammonia system the mechanics, service employees and management staff are polite, courteous and most of all follow our strict GMP's to the letter. In other words I do not have to worry about them on site. The Process Safety Management program for Ammonia that we have at Kraft is a very detailed and secure system and the fact that Cimco follows all the guidelines makes them a major part of our program.
